The successful applicant will deliver high-quality, Christ-centred teaching and learning for students in Years 6 – 8, with a focus on STEM learning, aligned with the Australian Curriculum (Version 9). They will promote student engagement, wellbeing, and achievement by creating meaningful learning experiences that encourage lifelong knowledge, personal growth, and Christian character formation.

Key Responsibilities

Curriculum & Teaching

- Plan, implement, and assess learning programs in accordance with the Education Australian Curriculum (Version 9) focusing on Science, Technologies, and Mathematics.
- Integrate Christian perspectives into teaching, encouraging students to view Science, Technologies, and Mathematics as integral parts of God's creation.
- Deliver engaging STEM lessons that build students' knowledge, problem-problem solving skills, collaboration, resilience, and appreciate of how STEM contributes to lifelong learning.
- Differentiate teaching to meet the needs of diverse learners.
- Use data and assessment to inform practice and track student progress.

Pastoral Care & Relationships

- Establish and maintain positive, respectful, and supportive relationships with students.
- Create safe and inclusive learning environments that promote respect, resilience, and collaboration.
- Partner with parents in supporting students' development.



Professional Practice

- Participate in collaborative planning with colleagues and contribute to faculty development.
- Engage in ongoing professional learning in pedagogy, curriculum, and Christian education.
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance, assessment, and reporting.
- Contribute to extracurricular activities, including camps, excursions and wellbeing initiatives, as required.

- ❖ Model Christ-like character and values in personal and professional life.
