They will promote student engagement, wellbeing, and achievement by creating meaningful learning experiences that encourage lifelong physical activity, personal growth, and Christian character formation.

Key Responsibilities

Curriculum & Teaching

- ❖ Plan, implement, and assess learning programs in accordance with the Health and Physical Education Australian Curriculum (Version 9).
- ❖ Provide engaging lessons that develop students' knowledge, movement skills, fitness, teamwork, resilience, and understanding of lifelong health and wellbeing.
- ❖ Differentiate teaching to meet the needs of diverse learners.
- ❖ Use data and assessment to inform practice and track student progress.
- ❖ Integrate Christian perspectives into teaching, encouraging students to view physical health and wellbeing as part of stewarding God's image in them.
- ❖ Work collaboratively with the Primary Health & PE Teacher to plan and coordinate school sporting events, including carnivals, cross country and gala days.

Pastoral Care & Relationships

- ❖ Establish and maintain positive, respectful, and supportive relationships with students.
- ❖ Create safe and inclusive learning environments that promote respect, resilience, and collaboration.
- ❖ Partner with parents in supporting students' development.



Professional Practice

- ❖ Participate in collaborative planning with colleagues and contribute to faculty development.
- ❖ Engage in ongoing professional learning in pedagogy, curriculum, and Christian education.
- ❖ Maintain accurate records of student attendance, assessment, and reporting.
- ❖ Contribute to extracurricular activities, including sport and wellbeing initiatives, as required.

Christian Commitment

- ❖ Model Christ-like character and values in personal and professional life.

- ❖ Commitment to professional growth, reflective practice, and collaboration with colleagues.
- ❖ Active membership of an evangelical Christian church and wholehearted support of the school's Christian mission and values.

Desirable

- First Aid and CPR certification (or willingness to obtain).
